

Spy'Ranger: the Flying Eyes of Operation Barkhane

After its launch in Mali, 8 years ago fighting against jihadism, the French President Emmanuel Macron has announced on the 10th of June the end of Operation Barkhane. Led by French armies since 2014 with G5 Sahel countries, Operation Barkhane has shown how important the UAV strategic role is in supporting dismounted soldiers. French Army trusts Thales <u>Spy'Ranger 330</u> to be the flying eyes during Operation Barkhan.



Here an example of an operational support:

While scouting a village west of Gossi, Desert Battle Bison infantrymen spotted two all-terrain vehicles fleeing, preceded by gunfire. We had to react quickly: the forward command post decided to deploy the SMDR.

The goal? Secure the progress of the troops, try to find the fugitives and acquire intelligence on the movements of the surrounding land.

"This is one of the functions of this system, [...] in a few minutes, we are the eyes of the battle group thanks to a real-time video mirroring screen and we are able to offer them intelligence on their entire sector" (Sgt. Alexis, a Spy'Ranger French operator)
